You will be given access to downloadable materials, suggested reading lists, and have the option to submit a lesson plan and self evaluation for comments from our team.

How it works

- The course has 10 hours' worth of content - a mixture of training videos, interactive tasks, and guided self-study.

- Before the end of your course, you can submit a lesson plan, and a self-evaluation of that lesson, to one of our teacher training team for feedback.

- Group bookings (10 or more) can arrange to have a series of live webinars with one of our training team.
