We are committed to ensuring that people with disabilities, including those with learning difficulties, and/or known medical conditions are treated fairly and given equal access to all our services.

We will make all reasonable adjustments to ensure that learners with a disability learning difficulty or known medical condition are not substantially disadvantaged.

The organisation wishes to ensure that we comply with the requirements of the Equality Act 2010 which includes the Disability Discrimination Act (as amended by the Special Educational Needs and Disability Equality Act of 2001 and the Duty to Promote Disability 2005).

We include in our policy:

- a definition of disability
- details on how students with disabilities should let us know about their needs
- Information on how we will provide support and how we will make plans for providing support. This will include information on where we may need to bring in external support.
- Technology and equipment available including
 - Hearing loop
 - Lift (and access for wheelchair users)
 - Photocopiers and access to large size print
- Exam arrangements (for those students taking external exams)
- Advice on accommodation
- Advice on travel to and from the school
